Greeting from the A.U.

The end of the year is upon us, so it's out with the old and in with the new. The sci-fi shows that have bit the dust are the Sci-fi Channel's The Flash, The Mantis, and Robo Cop; Fox's The Visitor: and just about everything on UPN. New shows coming in January are: Space: Above and Beyond, Earth2, and American Gothic to the Sci-Fi Channel and Babylon 5 to TNT.

American Gothic premieres on Friday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> at 8 P.M. and there will be four never seen before episodes. Space: Above and Beyond premieres on Sunday, January 11<sup>th</sup> at 7 P.M. with a 2 hour. Pilot. Its regular time slot will be on Sundays at 8 P.M. Earth2 premieres on Sunday, January 11th at 9 P.M. with a 2 hour. Pilot. Its regular time slot will be Sundays at 9 P.M.

Although the Sci-fi Channel's website still promotes a new Sliders season, rumors are that Sliders is gone for good.

Now on to the biggest premiere of the new year, Babylon 5 on TNT. It premieres on January 4th at 8 P.M. with "In the Beginning" an original 2 hour. TV-movie prequel covering the Earth-Minbari Wars. Immediately following this at 10 P.M. will be the 2 hour pilot "The Gathering", re-edited and re-scored.

They will both be re-shown starting at 12:30 A.M. On January 5th, TNT begins showing the first season episodes, uncut and in order, Monday-Friday at 7 P.M. So for those of you that want to find out what Babylon 5 is all about (like me) or just want to catch up, now is the time to check it out.

Babylon 5's fifth season starts on TNT on Wednesday, January 21st at 10 P.M. with a replay of that week's episode on the following Saturday at 7 P.M. This will conclude Babylon 5's five year arc. There is no sixth season planned, although TNT has

not ruled out a few TV-movies further down the line.

Something else to look forward to is Penn and Teller coming to Babylon 5 in March of 1998. They will be guest starring in an episode called "Day of the Dead" as a bumbling comedy team called Rebo and Zooty, the 23<sup>rd</sup> century's answer to Laurel and Hardy.

Out in cyberspace, TNT plans to go all out on their Babylon 5 website. You can go there now but it is still under construction. They promise it will be ready in time for its January premiere. Its address is <http://tnt.turner.com/babylon5/>.

You can get the new trailer for the X Files movie at their website [www.thex-files.com](http://www.thex-files.com). It takes about 2hrs. to download. It is a biggie, but well worth the wait. Also, I have copies of the online chats from the Sci-Fi Channel's online convention, SCIFI Con 2.0. I have Leonard Nimoy (TOS), Clancy Brown (Earth2, Starship Troopers), John Delancie (STNG), Jerry O'Connell (Sliders), Michael Ironside (Starship Troopers), and J. Michael Straczynski (Babylon 5). 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## SICKBAY

"To See, or Not to See?"

As most of you are aware, I have recently converted to contact lenses from eyeglasses.. However, some of you may not know about another procedure to correct poor eyesight: radial keratotomy, or "RK."

Radial keratotomy is a procedure by which a laser light is used to correct poor vision by reshaping the retina, the part of the eye on which light images fall and are transmitted to the brain by the optic nerve. The retina can become damaged or be out of shape and, therefore, transmit the wrong image to the brain. More often than not, the image on the retina is out of focus because the eyeball is not perfectly spherical or round. Thus, the picture "formed" on the retina falls either in front of or behind the retina, causing a blurry image as interpreted by the brain.

RK surgery is able to correct his problem by reshaping either the retina itself or the eyeball (cornea) by "shaving" a small part of the affected area in the eye. This is done in an optometrist's office in only about an hour's time and recovery time is often less than 24 hours. In rare instances, however, the procedure can last longer and recovery time extended due to complications such as a preexisting condition such as glaucoma.

Should you decide to have this procedure performed, I urge you to discuss this surgery with your physician and your optometrist and weigh the pros and cons. Your eyesight is the most important gift you are given: take great care of it!
