This is one of many common exhortations that encourage Klingons to respond to situations appropriately.

After the Enterprise's initial encounter with the entity Q, Worf gave voice to this attitude. He advised Captain Jean-Luc Picard that "our only choice is to fight." If we Klingons understand anything, it is the meaning of that kind of talk.

"Encounter at Farpoint"

We fight to enrich the spirit.

qa' wIje'meH maSuv.

A more literal translation of this Klingon phrase is "We fight in order to feed the spirit," focusing more on the role of the giver of enrichment (the Klingon) than that of the recipient (the spirit). For Klingons, the spirit is something that must be cared for actively. As the clone of Kahless pointed out, fighting is more than a physical activity: "We do not fight merely to spill blood, but to enrich the spirit." Interestingly, because of the homophony of the Klingon words for "feed" and "buy," both "je'," the phrase could also be translated as "We fight in order to buy the spirit." If this is not mere coincidence, then, perhaps, to the Klingon way of thinking, while one is alive, one must sacrifice or give up something (the way one uses credits or latinum when making a purchase) in order to ensure that the spirit is one's own.

Greetings from the A.U.

I have just recently started watching Babylon 5 this last year and I am completely hooked. And as I'm slightly obsessive-compulsive, I started looking for some of the best B5 sites on the web. Two of the best are The Lurker's Guide to Babylon 5 @ [www.midwinter.com/lurk](http://www.midwinter.com/lurk) and the TNT: Home of Babylon 5 @ <http://tnt.turner.com/babylon5>.

The Lurker's Guide to B5 is the ultimate guide to the series. For all newcomers to B5 this is a must. The Lurker's Guide offers in-depth analysis of the episodes, the characters, and the five year story. Each episode is broken down, analyzed, and cross referenced with the series books and comics. Each episode is given a rating (from 1-10) and series creator, J..Michael Straczynski also provides his input, answering questions and discussing the episodes. This site also has viewing schedules, cast interviews, books and comics reviews, and convention information.

The TNT site, is the official Babylon 5 website. Here you can find all things B5. There are electronic postcards which are free and you can send to all your online friends. There are currently thirty to choose from but more are added monthly. There is an episode guide and a monthly viewing calendar; cast photos and profiles; links to other B5 sites, chats, and bulletin boards. It has a training simulator that you can download for free and try out your fighting skills. There is a FAQ and an archive of past goodies. In the archive you can find information about the new B5 series, Crusade. There are rough sketches of the new ship, The Excalibur, and its interior.

For those of you not online, the new series is called Crusade, and is set some years after the end of B5 and the end of the Telepath War. The premise is that

an ally of the Shadows has developed a deadly plague to wipe out humanity and a group of Rangers

has been sent to discover its cure. Casting is still on going but so far Gary Cole (American Gothic) has signed on as Captain Matthew Gideon. Other cast members are David Allen Brooks as Max Eilerson; Carrie Dobro as Dureena Nafeel; Marjean Holden

as Dr. Susan Chambers; Daniel Dae Kim as Lt. Matheson; and Peter Woodward as Galen. Rumored to appear from the original B5 cast are Jeff Conway and Tracy Scoggins. Crusade is set to begin in January 1999. The B5 TV movie, A Call to Arms, set to air January. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1999 will set up the events that lead to the start of Crusade. TNT is rumored to have already ordered all five seasons of Crusade.

The next B5 TV movie to air on TNT is River of Souls. It will bring back the Soul Hunters last seen in the first season. Martin Sheen has signed on to guest star. It airs November 23, 1998.

## TREK BUZZ

A Star Trek stamp will among those issued by the Post Office in 1999 as part of a collection of stamps representing the 1960s. ST was one of various subjects selected in voting by the general public, receiving over a quarter million votes. Number one in the 1960s voting was a stamp to commemorate Man on the Moon, receiving over a half million votes.

Star Trek received the following six Emmy nominations this year:

1. Outstanding Art Direction for a Series ("Far Beyond the Stars," DS9)

2. Outstanding Costume Design for a Series ("Far Beyond the Stars," DS9)

3. Outstanding Hairstyling for a Series ("Far Beyond the Stars," DS9 and "The Killing Game, Part I and II," VOY)

4. Outstanding Makeup for a Series ("Who Mourns for Morn," DS9)

5. Outstanding Music Direction ("His Way," DS9)

6. Outstanding Special Visual Effects for a Series ("One Little Ship," DS9 and "Year of Hell, Part II," VOY)

Ezri Dax, the next host, will be played by Nicole deBoer. Ezri's plot twist will be that she took the symbiont to save its life and never wanted to be joined.

Paramount paid \$1.25 million for the rights to the documentary "Trekkies", which Paramount plans to release to theaters. Trekkies was produced by Denise Crosby (Tasha Yar).

Speaking of Denise Crosby, she gave birth to son August William Sylk on the 17<sup>th</sup> June!

Voyager has filmed its 100th episode, directed by LeVar Burton.

The Sci-Fi Channel will be running a sweepstakes between September and October 8th as part of promoting their carrying TOS starting 1 September. Grand prize is a week in Germany for the kickoff of the "Star Trek World Tour."

Paramount Video releases the Talking Tribble Gift Set on October 6th: the videos for "The Trouble with Tribbles" and "Trials and Tribble-ations" along with a tribble that "shrills" when squeezed!
