Sorbo and Majel Barrett Roddenberry are two of the executive producers, while former DS9 staffer Robert Hewitt Wolfe co-executive produces.

Sorbo plays Dylan Hunt, captain of the Commonwealth ship Andromeda, a Federation-like political entity, which has collapsed after civil war and Hunt is out to restore society.

Andromeda will be syndicated. It currently has sixty stations (covering sixty percent of the country) signed on for a two-year deal, with the series premiere scheduled for fall 2000.
