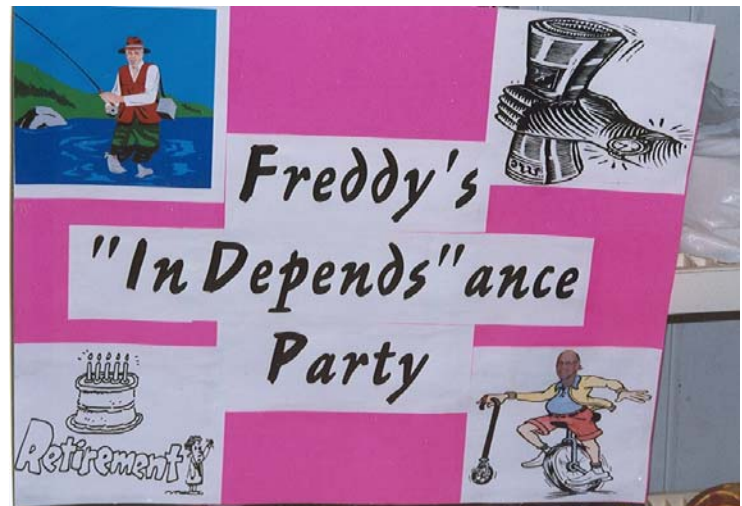

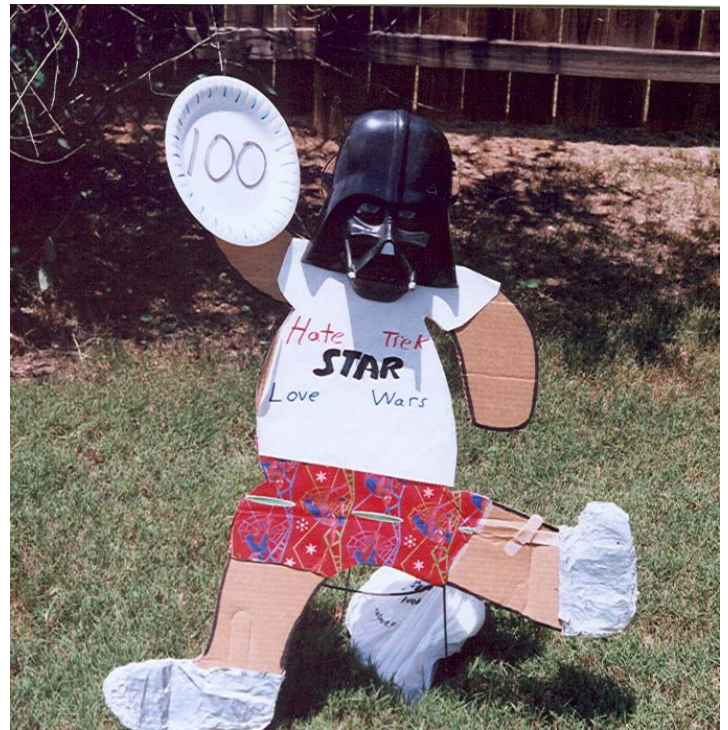

sudden rainstorm. Nonetheless, following the rain, several folks did take advantage of the break in the weather to play volleyball and croquet.

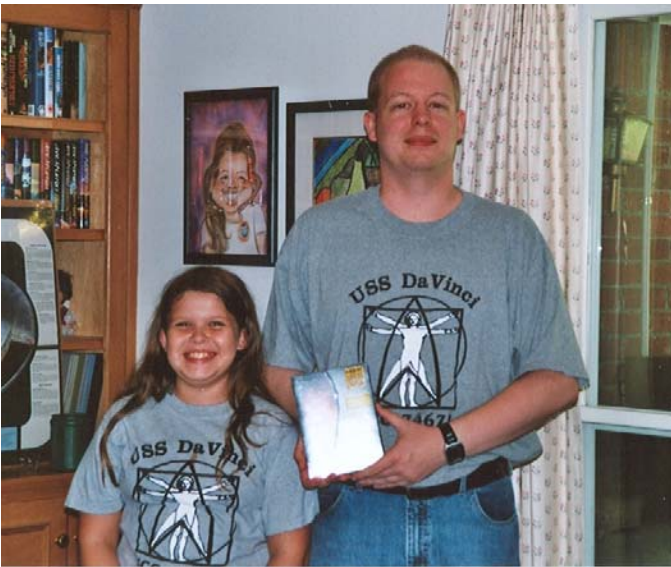


One of Randy's Frisbee targets.

Musical guests include Steve Carlson (Rock, Folk Rock) and Jason Manns (Rock, Folk Rock). Tickets run from \$30.00 for a daily pass to \$325.00 for a Platinum ticket. Hotel runs \$119.00 per night.

The fall Vulkan show is scheduled from 31 October – 02 November. The guest list is pretty impressive and covers many shows from the sci-fi genre.
