DRAGON CON

Labor day weekend has a lot of meaning to a lot of different people. To some, it is a few days off to rest and recover from long hours in the office. To others it is yet another weekend to enjoy good company filled with lots of hours enjoying family and friends' company. Even to take and have a cookout with your closest family and friends. But, to fans, it is a chance to interact with their favorite famous idols of stage and screen from present and past days. DragonCon is not just a fandom event; it is a time for everyone to celebrate the labors of their icons and friends.

This was my second year at DragonCon (www.dragoncon.com) and every year it gets better and better. The event spans four days over four hotels. The fee is pretty moderate, depending on when you elect to confirm your entrance into the event. The stars and topics are as vast as the movies and topics that are out for the world to view. Tracks as they call them are merely subjects that the event discusses throughout the weekend. Some of these topics are, for lack of a better word, unique and

intriguing. Tracks included James Bond, Star Trek, Tolkien's Middle Earth, Stargate Multi-Universe (covering all of the Stargate franchise), American Sci-Fi Classics, the Paranormal, Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Babylon 5, Buck Rogers, among many others. The tracks give the onlookers a wide variety of information to choose from. Some of these Tracks even went so far as to hold panels with stars from them. Writers and authors gave insight into producing your own work, plus how you can write and produce your own.

Dealers took and covered two rooms which were full of unique and different vendors all wanting to provide customers anything and everything a fan would want or wish for. Items included patches of SG-1, SG-12, Babylon 5, GI Joe, and even the patch held by the military members standing with Optimus Prime in Transformers. Many of the dealers had the standard items of figures from various movies and TV shows, water prints and even some had the various episodes of the TV and movies that we all know and love. Another unique item was the leather and chain mail that were used in the Roman and Celtic times. Lots of vendors spent time to set up unique and very good looking areas to display their work; I was very amazed at how the individuals displayed their merchandise in such a small area. The vendors knew the items that

they were selling, and gave reasonable prices for them. If it were not for some of the vendors assisting me in the items I had question of, I may not have been able to get a good understanding of the items that I needed and wanted.

Other items that some vendors had for sale were very elaborate and also very unique to the various movies. One vendor had an area just set up for Star Wars items. These Items ranged from the cloak that is symbolic to Jedi. Other items ranged from pistols to light sabers. Other vendors had mainly Star Trek merchandise: new Trek officer shirts ranging from Voyager, Enterprise, Next Generation and even the original Star Trek tricorders were on hand for purchase.

Onward to the panels with the stars. Who are they and what did they say about the shows and even the comedy that played a role in their daily taping. Panels ranged from Stargate SG-1, Stargate Atlantis, Buffy The Vampire Slayer, and one that caught my eye was Buck Rogers. Both Erin Gray and Gil Gerard were on site discussing the comedy and especially their lives during this period. This panel was unique to me because there was so much that I did not know about the show. In addition to the fact I had been a fan of both for years, and wanted to hear them one on one about it. Their panel was held on Friday night, but their information and discussion were truly divine.

During the discussion, the guest speakers explained the life on the set. Gil was known to be the main trickster around the set. However, the change in the uniform style was a hot topic because of the issues with the tightness of the spandex. Gil for example, explained that the actors and actresses had to wear a silk piece underneath the spandex. The spandex put grooves in their skin at the end of every taping. Gil worked with many of the leadership of the show to change the uniforms. When the changes came to play into it was raved by the show. There were many great actors that were mentioned during the panel explaining that they were all unique and it was hard to pick just one. Jack Palance was mentioned as to spinning a red cape that he used all around the set during his stay as guest. Gil and Christopher discussed the new Buck Rogers series that will be coming out late next year. RM HOUSE NEEDED ITEMS




USS DAVINCI IN PHOTOS


