




IT'S THE CAPTAIN CALLING



PASSAGES

The Trek world is saddened to learn of the passing of Warren Stevens, who died on March 27 at the age of 92, succumbing to chronic lung disease. Warren Stevens was a lanky, square-jawed actor with swept-back hair and a husky voice whose face became familiar through his more than 100 roles on television and in movies over six decades

A veteran character actor, Stevens' stage, film and television career spanned from the late-1940's to the late-2000's and included everything from Actor's Studio, Twilight Zone, Gunsmoke, Police Woman, ER, and dozens of other shows throughout his illustrious career.

While Mr. Stevens would make appearances on dozens of other television series, perhaps his best-known role was in the classic 1956 science fiction movie "Forbidden Planet." He played the ill-fated Doc Ostrow, who perishes at the hand of a mysterious force on the planet Altair IV, 16 light years from Earth, after his spaceship arrives to search for a long-lost colony.

Trek fans know him best as the Kelvan leader Rojan in the second-season Star Trek: The Original Series episode "By Any Other Name."


Mr. Stevens is survived by his wife of 43 years, the former Barbara Fletcher, and their two sons, Adam and Mathew; and a son, Laurence, from a previous marriage, to Susan Huntington.


Some of the crew at the Golden Corral.




