

## SCIENCE STATION

Hello everyone.

So over the last few months there has been a lot of exciting news. First, the Space X has made its way into having a reusable rocket and landing pad. So now it moves further into the race to longer distance travel. Next, would be Elon Musk's proposed plans for long range travel autonomously with a crew. This planned mission is to go around the moon and return home. The crew you may wonder is going to be from the private sector the last time it was discussed. This mean the individuals who are going have to pay their own way.

Further in the news arena is a company in Israel that has been testing a new more flexible radiation shield that can cover the main parts of the human body and protect against exposure. More flexibility means longer time in the suit and longer travel times in space without having to be bombarded with large amount of radiation. So the projected path for the Martian colony is well on its way. Along with other many advancements like with the 3d printing of food using

protein molecules include more air stream and quicker recovery rockets. Musk is designing a freighter system to carry supplies back and forth to the red planet.

This year we may actually see the rise to the quantum computer. What is a quantum computer? Well it's a computer that can hold enormous amounts of data. Down at the limits of physics, that solid material give rise to so-called quasi-particles, whose unusual behavior gives them the potential to serve as the key components of quantum computers. In a few years they could rewrite encryption, materials science, pharmaceutical research, and artificial intelligence. 




