

## FROM THE CENTER SEAT


Well, the “brr” months are upon us! Hard to believe that it is September already! Pretty soon we will have to plan for our annual Thanksgiving and Christmas parties.

## 678<sup>th</sup> STARFLEET MARINES

Greeting Marines!

So what does it take to be a HAM operator?

There are different levels of licenses you can obtain when becoming an Amateur Radio operator, the first being the technician license. There are currently four different levels of licenses and with each step up you are given more frequency privileges. It's not hard to get your license. All tests are multiple choice and you can buy books to study or even go online to study. All the questions have one right answer and all the exact questions and answers are given to you to memorize. How easy is that when you have the answers to the test? I do have to say though, you will have to do some studying to learn the basics of radio communication and about electronics. You don't have to have any experience with any of it and a lot of kids (some I've see are eight and ten years old) even have their amateur radio licenses. That's how easy it really is.

The Amateur Radio service as a hobby is very rewarding also. You never know who you might get to talk to as the Amateur Radio Service is worldwide. There's even an amateur radio station on the International Space Station. There also used to be an Amateur Radio station on the space shuttles before they were decommissioned. I was able to talk with an astronaut even on one of the space shuttle missions years ago. I had a schedule of the fly overs and because they are in space it doesn't take much to reach them. I actually talked to an astronaut who was on the Space Shuttle Discovery that was from Belgium. All I used to talk to him was a simple, hand held walkie-talkie and 5 watts of power. After the communication with him, which only lasted 45 seconds, he sent me a QSL card which is like a postcard from an Amateur Radio operators with all their information and sometimes their picture. His had a picture of him in his space suit pictured right on front. Many famous people are also Amateur Radio operators from Barry Goldwater to Patty Loveless to the King of Jordan. I even have a friend who talked to the King of Jordan and has a QSL card from him.

So what is it Amateur Radio operators talk about and do when you're not helping in disasters? Sometimes we just talk about Amateur Radio stuff, our new equipment or where we're going to eat lunch on Fridays. We also have what we call "Nets" which are like meetings over the air. Everyone checks in from wherever they're at, but things are kept formal and it's also how we practice over the air communications and protocol. Along with just talking over the air waves, just like those of us on the DaVinci, we are also a social organization with friends and family. We have local clubs and we even go out to eat on a monthly basis like we do on the DaVinci. Throughout the year we have different events such as field day which is a day in June that the entire world competes to make as many contacts as we can for our countries and often those of us in the United States receive prizes and awards from the ARRL (Amateur Radio Relay League). The ARRL is like the NRA for gun owners, but they represent Radio Amateurs.

If you think you might like to become an Amateur Radio operator, feel free to get with me and I'll be glad to show you more. It'd be a great and fun way to volunteer our time as Marines. Until next time, Ooh Rah!

## NEWS YOU CAN USE!

The new rates for membership in Starfleet are in place and are a pretty good deal. NOTE: There are no more paper memberships available. All memberships are electronic (via email). If you are thinking of joining Fleet but the expense was too high now you can get your membership for much less money. Not only will you save money there, but your membership in the DaVinci is half off as well (up to a \$7.50 savings!) and you are automatically promoted to Acting Ensign! The new Starfleet membership rates are: Individual - \$5; Family of 2 - \$9; Family of 3 - \$12; Family of 4 - \$14; Family of 5 - \$16; and Family of 6 - \$17. Paper membership certificates are no longer available – all memberships are now completely digital. However, if you wish a paper certificate it will cost you \$3.00 for each one plus shipping. If you want a printed copy of the Starfleet handbook it will cost you \$8.00 plus shipping. If you are not in Starfleet, please give some thought about joining this great organization!




### DID YOU KNOW THAT?






## USS DAVINCI IN PICTURES




