

StarFleet HQ is threatening to move up to dry dock status if we continue to show no activities. This will NOT affect the status of the club, we WILL continue.


If anybody has any ideas for activities, let me know.

In honor of National Adopt A Cat Month, we turn our attention to the most famous feline in all of Star Trek: Spot.

The beloved orange cat belonging to Lt. Commander Data made "his" screen debut in the Next Generation season four episode "Data's Day." That's right, Spot was originally referred to as a male cat, though she has since come to be officially a female character. Spot is apparently a 'spicy' kitty, only liking a small handful of humanoids. To everyone else, she's a fluffy terror, even sending Commander Riker to Sickbay with deep facial lacerations on at least one occasion.

Being a cat, Spot naturally steals every scene she's in. But purrhaps her most important appearance is in the 'Next Generation' season seven episode "Genesis." In this episode, a mutated virus de-evolves the Enterprise crew into animalistic creatures. Even Spot is not immune, having turned into an iguana as she gave birth to her litter of kittens. It's those tiny kittens, still very much feline with nary a scale in sight, that inspire the cure to the crew's predicament. Spot passed on an immunity to her babies which prevented them from becoming infected. With this discovery, Data and Picard are able to figure out how to return the crew to their normal selves. This episode could be summarized as "Spot Saves The Enterprise," and is thus arguably her most important 'Next Generation' moment.





Spot has been played by (at least) eight cats and an iguana. Spot's debut featured an unknown long-haired Somali cat, but it wasn't long before Spot's look was switched to an orange tabby, and new feline actors were cast for the part. Monster, Brandy, Bud, and Tyler played Spot in 'Star Trek: The Next Generation.' For the season seven episode "Genesis" Spot was also played by Willie the iguana. Monster and Brandy reprised their roll as Spot for the movie "Star Trek Generations," and were joined by backup cats Spencer and Zoe. Although Spot briefly

appears in the movie "Star Trek Nemesis," there is apparently no record of what feline actor played the part. Likewise there is no information on what feline actor played the memory of Spot in season three of "Star Trek: Picard."

While Spot is the most famous Star Trek kitty, she's not the only feline to ever grace a Federation vessel. Excluding Caitians and shape-shifters (of which there have been several) leaves us with a short list of space cats. Chester appears in two episodes of 'Star Trek: Deep Space

Nine.' This fluffy tabby and white feline came to live with the O'Brien family after his first owner came to an ill end. Miles and Molly were fond of the cat, but Keiko was far less enthusiastic with the feline addition to their family. Moving on to 'Star Trek: Voyager' we have Neelix, a pale Persian belonging to Reginald Barclay. Barclay obtained the cat after transferring to the Pathfinder Project, and named him after the Talaxian crew member of USS Voyager. Our final feline of note is Grudge, a very large and fluffy brown tabby who belongs to Cleveland Booker. Grudge is described as "a queen" and appears in multiple episodes of "Star Trek: Discovery."


