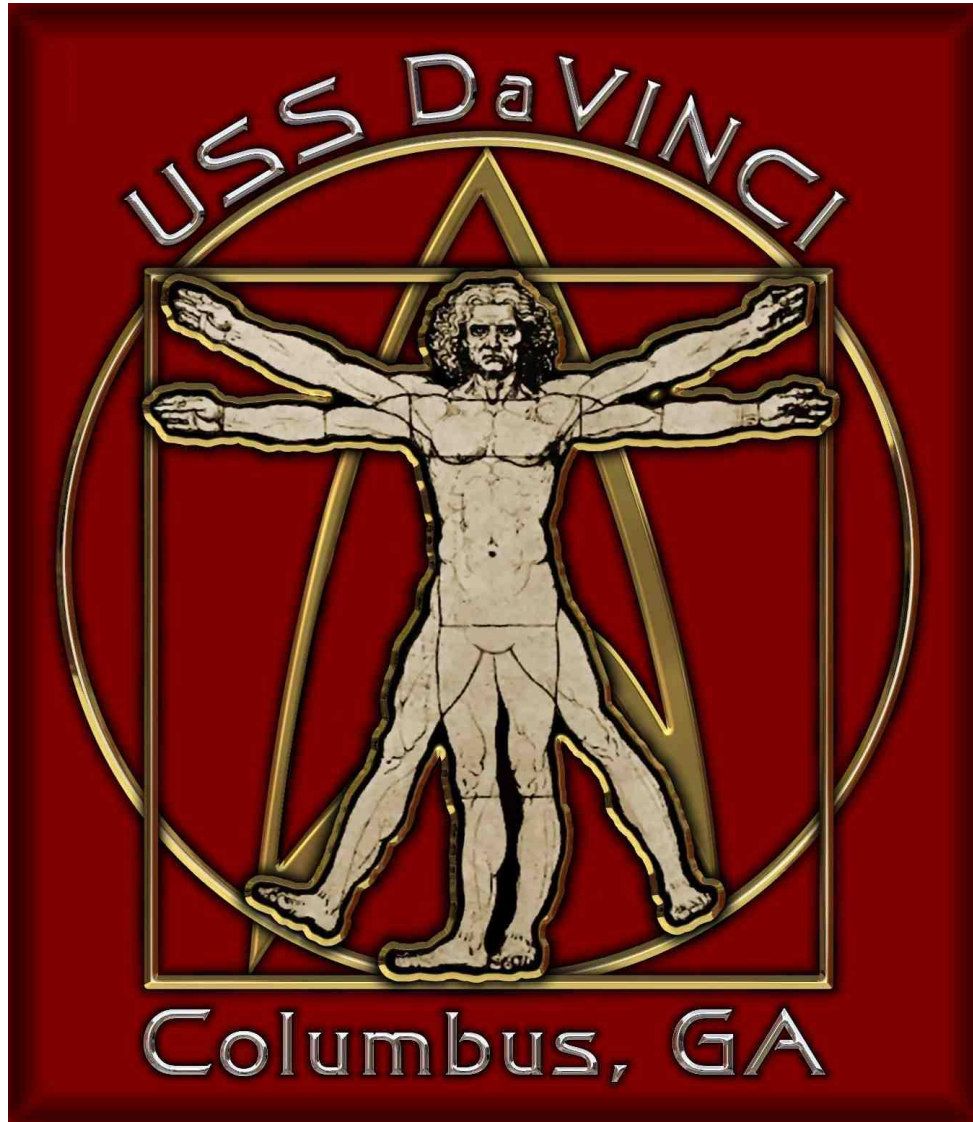

COSPLAY & CRAFTS

The time has come when many of us adorn our abodes with festive décor. Whatever holiday you're celebrating (or not), this month's craft project is something everyone or all ages can enjoy: DIY Star Trek ornaments! This DaVinci exclusive is a print, color, cut out, and glue sort of activity. I did two versions; one with a hole for photos, and one with no photo holes. Ornaments include the Star Trek 'arrowhead' symbol, USS Enterprise-D, original USS Enterprise, Vulcan Salute, and USS Voyager (or USS DaVinci as both are Intrepid class).

DIY Star Trek Ornaments

Materials:

Photos (can be personal photos, images of your favorite Star Trek character, or your own art)

Printer (if you don't own one, try your public library)

Paper (cardstock recommended; sticker paper if you have it)

Thin Cardboard (cereal box recommended; any similar thin cardboard box works)

Coloring Supplies (Colored Pencils work best; Markers might cause printed lines to bleed)

Glue (gluestick or any craft glue will work)

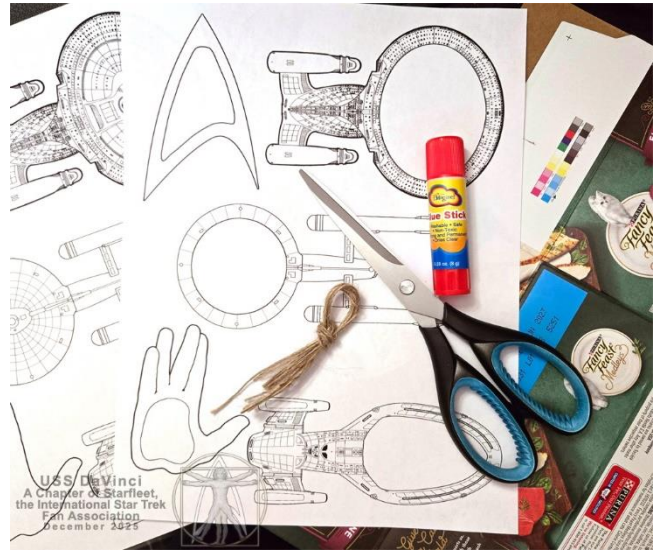
Tape (optional but useful)

Scissors (also recommend Xacto Knife if you have one)

Thin Ribbon or String (any color)

Wire Ornament Hook (optional)

Hole Punch (optional)



Instructions:

1. **Print** the provided ornament pages. (You'll find them below.)
2. **Color ornaments.** This is easiest to do pre-glue. If using markers, be aware they might make the printed lines 'bleed' a bit.

It is recommended to color around the outside edges and back with black so you don't have any white edges showing when you cut out your ornaments.

3. **Glue paper onto cardboard.** You can roughly cut out the individual ornaments before gluing if using a smaller box. Make sure to smooth out your glue so the paper doesn't bubble and warp. You don't need a lot of glue to hold the paper on. If using sticker paper, just peel and stick.



4. **Cut out the shapes.** Be careful, especially if using an Xacto knife. For the photo ornaments, you can either cut out the hole as intended, or leave it solid and glue your cut-to-fit photo on top.

5. **Cut your photos** so they'll fit nicely in the ornament's hole. Cut photos to match the hole outline if you've left your ornament solid. Make sure you like how the images are positioned on the ornament. Glue or tape photos in place.



6. **Decide** whether you want to punch a hole in the ornament for hanging, or glue the hanging loop to the back. Cut a length of ribbon or yarn approximately 9 inches long.

- **If gluing**, tie the ends of your ribbon to create a loop. Glue the knotted end to the back of your ornament. (You can also tape it on, or use hot glue.)

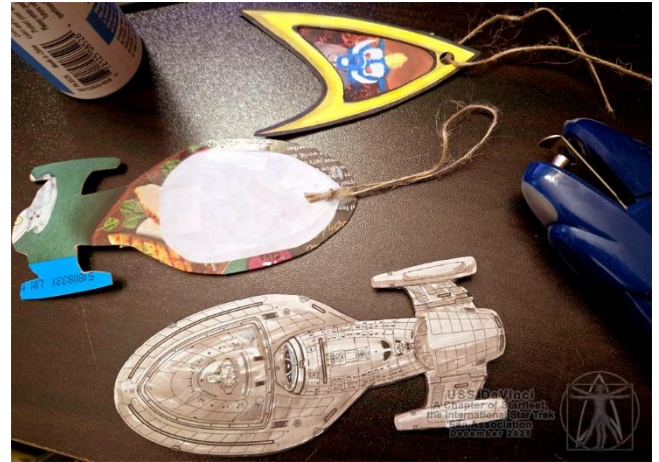
- **If punching a hole**, you will thread your ribbon or string through the hole and tie it to form a loop.

Add a wire ornament hook to the ribbon loop if you so desire.

7. **Hang** your personalized Star Trek ornament and enjoy that feeling of pride in your creation.

For Double-Sided Ornaments:

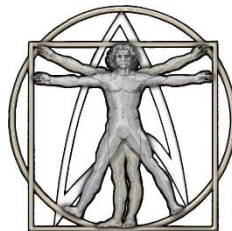
If you want double-sided ornaments, glue a no-hole ornament to the back of a corresponding photo-hole ornament. Color the “back” of printed Arrowhead and Vulcan Salute ornaments so they’ll match the “front” side when glued together. The ship ornaments are symmetrical so color the printed “front” side as normal.

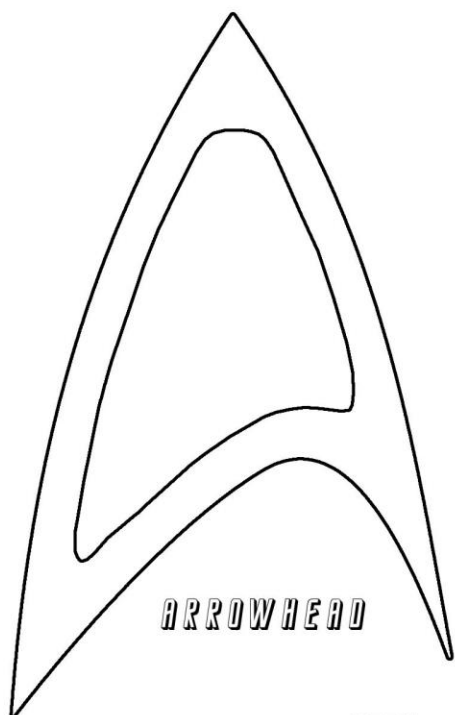


When you get to Step Six above, if gluing your hanging loop, glue loop to “front” side of ornament, then glue “back” side to the “front.” Recommend you clean glue off edges and place it under a heavy object (such as a book) to hold the two sides together flat while the glue dries.

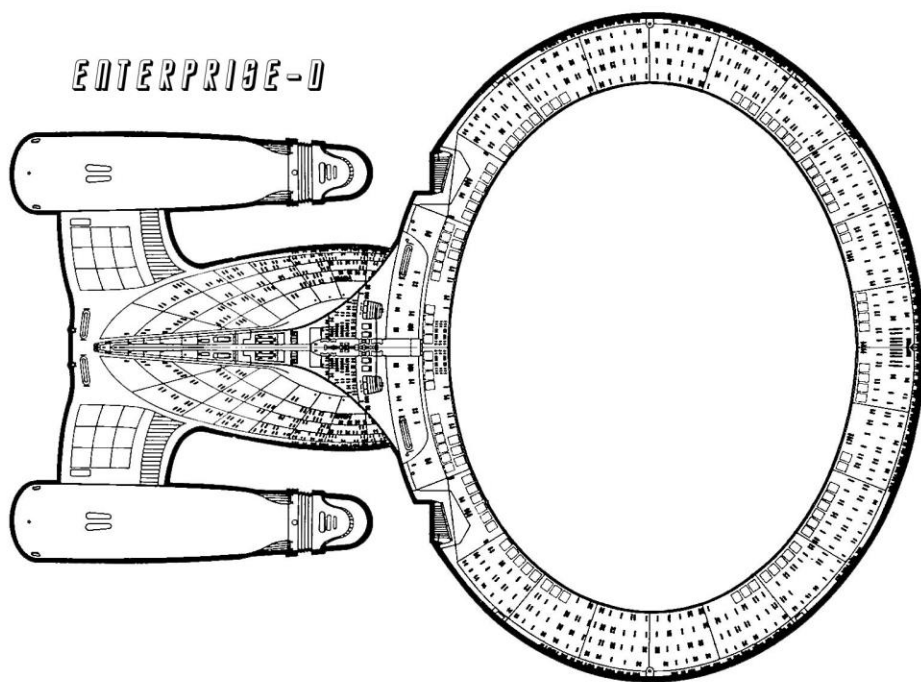
If punching a hole, do so on “front” side of ornament, then glue the two halves together as previously instructed. When glue is dry, align hole-punch over existing hole and punch through the “back.” Now insert your ribbon/string as directed in Step Six.

Feel free to get creative! For example, glue a magnet to the back of your ornament and stick it on the fridge. Use them as gift tags, or place them inside a greeting card as a handmade gift. Use your imagination and have fun.

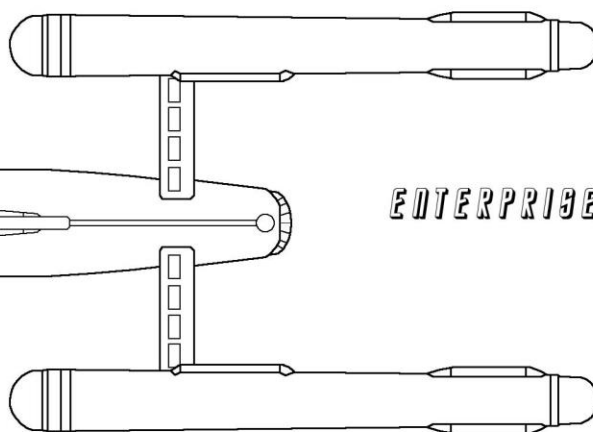
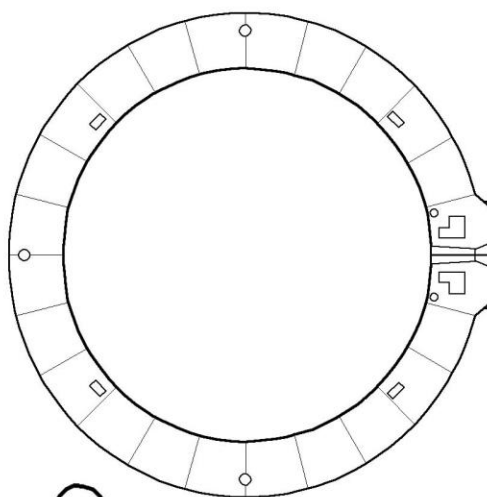




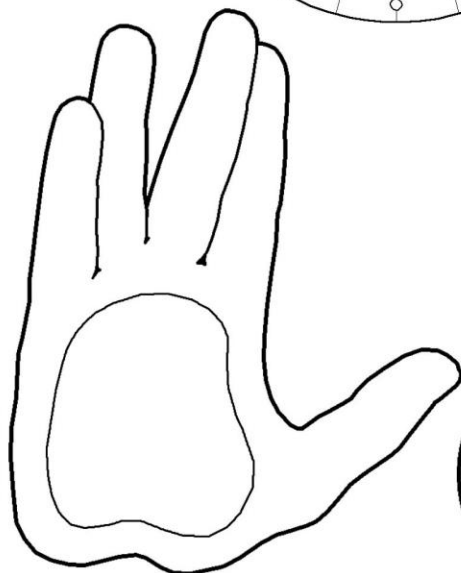
